## Introduction

Within the institutional framework of the European Union the relationship between the national legal systems and Union law is a very complex topic. The supremacy of Union law, as it was developed by the European Court of Justice, could stand in conflict with Art 117 of the Italian constitution, which regulates the legislative power of the state and the regions and includes the fundamental rights as central issue. The main players in this matter are the European Court of Justice, the European Court of Human rights and the national Constitutional Courts. Prof. Troiano discusses the relationship between those key players using the example of Italy. Focussing on the connection between the national judges in Italy's Supreme Court and Constitutional Court on the one hand and the European Court of Justice and the European Court of Human Rights on the other hand he offers some new thoughts about a future European Bill of Rights.

Prof. Troiano teaches at the Law Faculty of the University of Foggia (Italy) »Private Law« and »European Private Law«. Beside private law and comparative law his research activities focus on Banking law, Insurance law and e-commerce law.
